NEW ENTRY PROCESS

Entries will be handled through **Eagerdog.com**.

~ To use **EagerDog**, you will need to create an account for yourself and register your dog(s).

~ You can enter your dogs into either trial or both trials. Eager Dog handles them separately.

~ Enter all your dogs for the trials before checking out.

~ There is a service charge for entering. The fee is 10% of the total charges. The fees are capped at \$10.00.

ENTRIES close Wednesday, October 16, 2026 at 6:00pm

after which time entries cannot be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the AKC Obedience Regulations.

VDTC will maintain a waitlist, should anyone need to cancel prior to the closing date.

After closing, all those who entered will receive an email giving them their armband numbers.

Bitches “in season” on the day of the show will be refunded entry fees, less \$10 upon presentation of a veterinarian certification and written request. This certificate must be given to the Trial Secretary 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

MOVE-UPS (Class Transfers) will be permitted at these trials in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the AKC Obedience Regulations. Please notify the Trial Secretary *in writing* as soon as possible, but at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

Passing scores in Excellent B and Advanced B will count toward the RAE

Notice to Exhibitors

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, pandemics or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, hurricanes, fire, lightning, extreme heat or earthquake, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The wellbeing of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event that it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Dogs cannot show at this trial if they have trained under the Judge within 10 days of the trial.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, free of any communicable disease and have appropriate vaccinations.

Additional Trial rules

The club is not responsible for loss or damage to any dogs entered, whether by accident or other cause. Dogs are in the custody of their owner or agent and must be on leash or confined to their vehicles except when in the ring.

DOGS WILL NEED TO BE CAR CRATED. No crates will be allowed in the building.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The club is not obligated to notify exhibitors of the start of judging. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring at the proper time.

DOGS NEED ONLY be present at the scheduled time of judging and will be excused when no longer needed for further judging.

IT IS EACH PARTICIPANT'S RESPONSIBILITY to clean up after his or her dogs. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

To potty your dogs, go directly across Las Juntas St. or diagonally across the street to the areas by the Courthouse and Veterans Building. There are garbage cans to dispose of dog waste around the corner by the Veterans Building. **Do NOT potty dogs directly across Ward Street from our parking lot.**

IN ORDER TO PREVENT loss of the facility for future events, Vallejo Dog Training Club asks that participants adhere to the facility's rules.

DIRECTIONS

From Oakland Area: Head north on I-80 to Exit 23 for CA-4 East. Take Exit 9 for Alhambra Ave toward Martinez. Make a SHARP LEFT onto Alhambra Ave and go about 2 miles. Turn RIGHT onto Green Street and go about 4 blocks. Turn LEFT onto Las Juntas. The parking lot will be on your left.

From SF Peninsula: Head north to San Francisco. Take the Bay Bridge to I-580 East to CA-24 East toward Walnut Creek. Take CA-24 to I-680 North (left lanes) to Exit 56 for Waterfront Rd / Marina Vista Ave and turn LEFT at the traffic light. Continue to Court Street and turn LEFT. Go 2 blocks and turn RIGHT on Main St. Go 1 block and turn LEFT on Las Juntas. The parking lot will be on your right. **Alternate Route:** Take the

San Mateo Bridge to either I-880 north or I-580 north. Then take CA-24 East to I-680 north and follow above directions to Exit 56.

From San Jose Area: Take I-680 North to Exit 56 for Waterfront Rd / Marina Vista Ave and turn LEFT at the traffic light. Continue to Court Street and turn LEFT. Go 2 blocks and turn RIGHT on Main St. Go 1 block and turn LEFT on Las Juntas. The parking lot will be on your right.

PARKING INFORMATION

Please car crate your dogs. There is a parking lot alongside the building. You may park in any spot in our lot, *except* those coned off for VDTC Personnel or equipment. You may also park on the street and in the parking lot across Ward Street behind the restaurants and shops. Meters are not enforced on the weekend.

The parking lot has no shade. Handlers may want to bring shade cloths to cover their car windows and windshields.

County Orders regarding Covid-19 will be enforced.
