ENTRIES CLOSE Wednesday, October 18, 2023 at 6:00 PM,

after which time entries cannot be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the AKC Obedience Regulations.

VDTC will maintain a waitlist, should anyone need to cancel prior to the closing date. After closing, all those who entered will receive an email giving them their armband numbers.

BITCHES ENTERED in OBEDIENCE/RALLY: if "in season" on the day of the show, will be refunded entry fees, less \$10. A veterinarian certification and written request are required. This certificate must be given to the Trial Secretary 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

MOVE-UPS (Class Transfers) will be permitted at these trials in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the AKC Obedience Regulations. Please notify the Trial Secretary *in writing* as soon as possible, but at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

Additional Trial rules

The club is not responsible for the loss or damage to any dogs entered, whether by accident or other cause. Dogs are in the custody of their owner or agent. Dogs must be kept on leash or confined to their vehicles or crates except when in the ring.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The club is not obligated to notify exhibitors of the start of judging. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring at the proper time.

DOGS NEED ONLY be present at the scheduled time of judging and will be excused when no longer needed for further judging.

DO NOT LEAVE DOGS UNATTENDED IN VEHICLES.

IT IS EACH PARTICIPANT'S RESPONSIBILITY to clean up after his or her dogs and to clean up his or her area after the show. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

GROUND INFORMATION and FACILITY RULES

Notice to Exhibitors

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, pandemics or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, hurricanes, fire, lightning, extreme heat or earthquake, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The wellbeing of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event that it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Dogs cannot show at this trial if they have trained under the Judge within 10 days of the trial.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, free of any communicable disease and have appropriate vaccinations.

All persons attending this show hereby waive any claims for damages against the Vallejo Dog Training Club, its members, the Event Secretary and/or California State University East Bay in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating.

DIRECTIONS

From Oakland Area: Take Hwy 580 East toward Hayward. Take Exit 34 to CA-238/Foothill Blvd toward Hayward. Continue on Foothill Blvd to "A" Street. Turn right onto "A" Street and go 2 blocks. Turn left onto Mission Blvd and go 0.2 miles. Turn left onto Carlos Bee Blvd, go up the hill and stay to the far right to enter the campus. At the stop sign, turn left and proceed to the rear of campus. Turn right at the stop sign, then turn right into Lot K.

From San Jose Area: Take Hwy 880 North toward Hayward. Take Exit #27 onto Jackson Street eastbound. Turn right onto Harder Road and go 1.4 miles to Mission Blvd. Turn left onto Mission Blvd and go 0.8 miles to Carlos Bee Blvd. Turn right onto Carlos Bee Blvd, go up the hill and stay to the far right to enter the campus. At the stop sign, turn left and proceed to the rear of campus. Turn right at the stop sign, then turn right into Lot K.

From SF Peninsula: Take the San Mateo Bridge (Hwy 92) east to Hayward. Continue past the intersection with Highway 880. Continue straight onto Jackson Street. Turn right onto Harder Road and go 1.4 miles to Mission Blvd. Turn left onto Mission Blvd and go 0.8 miles to Carlos Bee Blvd and get in the right turn lane. Turn right onto Carlos Bee Blvd, go up the hill and stay to the far right to enter the campus. At the stop sign, turn left and proceed to the rear of campus. Turn right at the stop sign, then turn right into Lot K.

GROUNDS INFORMATION and FACILITY RULES

PARKING: Park in Lot K (see Directions above). Free parking on Saturdays & Sundays.

I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, providers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
